

The Community Engagement Awards honor three individuals who are leading with a commitment to improve our region and embrace Leadership Austin's values.





Outstanding Alumni Award - Hon. Rudy Metayer, Emerge 5-2011 and Essential 36-2015, is a dedicated legal professional representing public and private entities in various cases, including bankruptcy, Medicaid fraud, personal injury, and administrative hearings. As the first-generation college graduate in his Haitian immigrant family, Rudy's impact goes beyond the courtroom. He advocates for community issues, teaches at-risk children, co-authored the University of Texas honor code, and fosters partnerships between law enforcement, the State Bar, and the community to address policing challenges.

Ascendant Alumni Award – **Nhat Ho, Essential 41-2022**, is the president of Civilitude Engineers & Planners, an Austin firm specializing in land development. With expertise in architectural design, engineering, permitting, and urban planning, he has made Civilitude a trusted partner in high-profile public-private projects. Co-founder of Capital A Housing, Ho champions affordable housing in Austin, working closely with government officials. As a serial entrepreneur, he mentors and invests in local businesses, promoting sustainable growth.





Honorary Alumni Award - Rep. Gina Hinojosa has represented House District 49 in Austin since 2016. A former Austin ISD School Board Trustee and President, she is a tireless advocate for public education, serving on key committees, including the House Public Education Committee and the House Select Committee on Educational Opportunity and Enrichment.
